# BLACK HEALTH ALLIANCE NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

### For the year ended March 31, 2013

### 1. ORGANIZATION AND PURPOSE

The Black Health Alliance ("Alliance") is a registered Charitable organization incorporated as a corporation with no share capital in the province of Ontario. The mission of the Alliance is to reduce the racial disparities in health outcomes and promote health and well-being for people from the diverse Black communities in Canada with emphasis on the broad determinants of health, including racism.

### 2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of Presentation

i) The Alliance follows Canadian generally accepted accounting principles in the preparation of its financial statements which require that the statements be prepared using the accrual method of accounting. Under the accrual method of accounting, revenues are recorded when earned and expenses are recorded when incurred.

Fund-Raising Events Revenues and Expenses

ii) Revenues and expenses from fund-raising events are recorded in the period in which the event takes place.

#### **Donations**

ii) Donations are recorded when received. Donated goods and services are not recorded in the accounts, except when they are used in the normal course of business and when a fair value for such goods and services can be readily determined.

### GENERAL

**Income Taxes** 

The organization is a registered Charity and while registered is exempt from income taxes.
